Regular Meeting to order

Glenn Burns called the Regular Meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance. The meeting was held with the following Board Members present: Glenn Burns, Michael Kaper, Bill McNeer, Bill Fagan, and Jon Kochis. Absent were Tom Brennan and Scott Richardson.

Also present was Staci Knisley, Kip Kelsey, Brandon Foster, Al Moyer, Eric Meister, Ian Coil, Pat Rooney, and Steve Clapper.

Opportunity for the Public to Address the Board

Mr. Steve Clapper presented a more formal proposal for the planning of his Air Show. He received his tax status from the state. He is waiting on more information from the IRS and FAA. In June or July, he expects to bring more information in to the Board related to the FAA.

Mr. Clapper stated that HAS is discussing having a Wings and Wheels show in July. He wants to make sure there are no hangars being built or any other type of construction during this time.

Mr. Kochis stated that the master hangar build discussion will be later on during the agenda.

Minutes for the February 13, 2023, Meeting

The board suggested a few changes in the presented minutes for clarifications.

Approval of the Minutes for the February 13, 2023, Meeting

On motion of Michael Kaper and second of Bill McNeer, the Fairfield County Airport Authority Board voted to approve the minutes as amended from the February 13, 2023, meeting.

Voting aye thereon: Kaper, McNeer, Burns, Kochis, and Fagan.

Absent were: Scott Richardson and Tom Brennan

Motion passed.

Historical Aircraft Squadron (HAS) update

Mr. Brandon Foster reported that HAS is running out of space for projects. They are turning down projects. They have some fundraising opportunities coming up to raise some money to put towards a new hangar. HAS would like to see if there is any interest from the Board of Commissioners for supporting a portion of the costs. They are even open to paying rent for the remaining portion of what HAS does not raise. HAS would also like to claim the area beside them for any future building.

Mr. Kochis recommended that HAS seek grant funding. He estimates that it would cost around \$1.5 million for a space identical to what HAS has today.

Mr. Foster also stated that HAS would also be interested to rent a corporate hangar from the county if built.

Mr. Kochis reported costs for rent would be around \$1,500-\$2,000 per month on a 60 x 60 hangar. He also recommended that HAS extend their showroom space and build on in the grass rather than the apron; freeing up your actual hangar space would maximize your dollar.

Mr. Kelsey asked if the Airport Board favors HAS extending on the current hangar if they raised enough money and sought out grant funding.

Mr. Kochis stated that he did not see this as a problem from the Airport Board's perspective. The Board of Commissioners would have to make the approval.

Mr. Kochis recommended seeking an estimate from a builder just to get an estimate, but it will still have to go out for public bid.

Mr. Foster stated that HAS will be at the Rickenbacker show in June. They will have 3 aircrafts, a tent, and a booth there.

<u>Fixed Base Operator (FBO)/Airport Management update with Sundowner Aviation – Monthly Board Report</u>

a. Monthly Report

Mr. Coil presented the FBO monthly report for the Board to review; see attached to minutes.

Mr. Kochis reported that the approach change draft is waiting for the FAA approval. We do not have a timeline at this time.

Standing Committee Updates:

Airport Improvement - Jon Kochis & Tom Brennan (absent)

a. Engineer's Summary Report - Crawford Murphy Tilly, Inc. (CMT)

Mr. Kochis reviewed the Engineer's Summary report; see attached to minutes.

Mr. Kochis reviewed the following change orders related to the drainage projects with Rock River Construction recommended by CMT:

o Change order #2 in the amount of \$8,690.

There were problems with the pipes being in the right place. In order to stick to the original plan and to keep things moving along, it is recommended by CMT that we backfill underneath the runway with solid concrete as a culvert and we will crush the pipe in the infield. There will still only be one cut on the runway. We are saving about \$30,000 by filling the culvert with concrete.

o Change order# 1 in the amount of \$ 36,015.

This change order involves the temporary displaced threshold by removing the markings and adjusting the lights on the runway. The original discussion related to the displaced threshold we estimated costs at \$75,000.

We will ask for amendments to the FY22 FAA grant at the closeout process. The costs will be paid out of Commissioners Capital dollars in hopes for FAA reimbursement.

Approval for change order number one (1) and number two (2) with Rock River Construction for the Airport drainage projects.

On motion of Jon Kochis and second of Bill Fagan, the Fairfield County Airport Authority Board voted to approve the change order number one (1) and number two (2) with Rock River Construction for the Airport drainage projects; see attached to minutes.

Voting aye thereon: Kochis, Fagan, Burns, McNeer, and Kaper.

Absent were: Scott Richardson and Tom Brennan

Motion passed.

Mr. Kochis reported that grade out estimate for the runway safety areas (RSAs) was too high. We declined that estimate and will seek other options.

Mr. Kochis continued reviewing the CMT Engineer Summary report with the Board.

b. Master Plan Hangar Build

Mr. Kaper reported that the Board of Commissioners, Treasurer's Office, and Bond Counsel are reviewing bonds and cash options for building new hangars.

Mr. Kochis reviewed the map of the areas where potentially the hangars will be built. The estimated costs for the T-Hangar project is about \$1.7 million. The Box Hangar project is approximately \$2.7 million. We presented to the Board of Commissioners that Priority #1 is for T-hangars, and the Box Hangars being the 2nd priority.

Mr. Kochis stated that if the Box Hangars are approved for the new build, he recommends that the spaces be publicly bid for leasing and awarded to the company that has the most economic impact to the county.

c. FY2024 Ohio Airport Grant Program

Mr. Kochis reported that the Fairfield County Transportation Improvement District is working with us on pushing a new access road to the Airport.

d. Construction Notice/Displaced Threshold

• Email request for waive of rental fees from Chris Calovini.

The Board declined the request to waive fees due to the displaced threshold. The airport will not be closed like we originally thought.

Mr. Kochis reported that Company Wrench and Gorsuch Aviation will not be able to use the displaced threshold during the construction.

e. Storm Water System Repair

Mr. Kochis reported that after the drainage project is completed, we should be able to go to FEMA for a map amendment to remove the floodplain on the north side of the Airport.

f. Obstruction Removal Project Nothing further to discuss.

g. Sewer and Water Line install.

Mr. Kochis reported that the project will run a new sewer line directly out of this building to the grass. Hangar J and the terminal will run into it. There will be a stub available for the Gorsuch hangar and beside the hangar along with any new hangars. This is at no costs to the airport. This is funded through ARPA funds.

It does require rebuilding the security fence. The aircrafts at HAS will have to remain outside the fence.

Mr. Foster asked if HAS could extend the fence at their costs to keep their aircraft and small building inside the fence.

Mr. Kelsey added that the security fence does deter people from going in and vandalizing.

Mr. Kochis stated he will ask the vendor if the fence can be incorporated to enclose all HAS equipment.

Community Relations - Michael Kaper

Mr. Kaper reported that there were a few emails related to potential employment at the Airport.

Facilities and Grounds - Bill Fagan & Michael Kaper

a. Hangar painting estimates

Mr. Fagan reviewed the painting estimates again. This was on hold from the February meeting.

Mr. Kochis stated that the displaced threshold markings will be potentially paid out of the FAA grant that would allow the budget for painting. He asked that this get discussed again in April.

b. Hangar J LED lights

Mr. Kochis will seek estimates and report back at the April meeting.

Fixed Base Operator (FBO) Liaison - Scott Richardson (absent)

Nothing new to report.

Finance - Glenn Burns & Staci Knisley




