Historical Aircraft Squadron (HAS) update

Mr. Moyer reported that the contractors knocked one of the taxiway lights over by running over it. It is near the pile of materials. He asked if the pile would be gone soon.

Mr. Kochis reported that JK pile is going to be there about 8 months to a year. It will be the new path to the HAS building.

Mr. Moyer asked about the progress on purchasing a new zero turn mower. He recommended a Kabota Diesel model # CD1211 be purchased.

Mr. Kochis reported that Mr. Brennan had received some quotes. The amount to purchase the new one will be \$19,300. It was approved to move forward at the June meeting with a not to exceed costs of \$20,000.

Ms. Knisley will work with Mr. Brennan on getting the purchase order encumbered.

<u>Fixed Base Operator (FBO)/Airport Management update with Sundowner Aviation – Monthly</u> Board Report

a. Monthly Report

Mr. Coil presented the FBO Monthly report; see attached to minutes.

Mr. Coil reported the gate is fixed but the motor is now not working. He has a call in for the repair. He also called Eversole Construction to look at one of the hangars.

Mr. Coil reported that during the taxiway construction it did not seem to impact the airport traffic. It seemed to run smoothly.

Airport Improvement - Jon Kochis & Tom Brennan (absent)

a. Engineer's Summary Report – Crawford Murphy Tilly, Inc. (CMT)

Mr. Kochis reviewed the Engineer's Summary report; see attached to minutes.

b. Storm Water System Repair

Mr. Kochis reported that Kull Excavating is pretty busy, but they should be getting to our project soon

Mr. Kochis reported that per the Soil & Water stormwater quarterly, it is recommended that we close and cap the Airport wells. It is estimated to cost \$2,400 plus permits for the 4 wells. He thinks it should not cost any more than \$2,900.

Mr. Kochis reported that CMT was the apparent low bidder for architectural and engineering services for the hangar project. The resolution for approval should be on next week at the Board of Commissioner meeting.

a. Hangar J LED lights

Mr. Kochis reported that when Mr. Shadd is ready, we will provide the materials from State Electric Supply for the installation.

Mr. Coil reported that there is still an aircraft in his hangar that is in the way.

Fixed Base Operator (FBO) Liaison – Scott Richardson

Mr. Richardson reported that he spoke with Mr. Clapper related to the hangar build project. He is worried it could be during his proposed Air Show in September of 2024.

Mr. Kochis stated that it is likely the construction will go on all summer but possibly could be ready by September or October.
