

1st AMENDMENT TO FAIRFIELD COUNTY AIRPORT AUTHORITY LAND LEASE AGREEMENT WITH SAS AVIATION PROPERTIES, LLC

This 1st Amendment is made and entered into effective upon execution by all parties hereto, by and among Fairfield County Airport Authority, ("Lessor"), and SAS Aviation Properties, LLC ("Lessee").

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

WHEREAS, the Lessor has the authority to enter into the Lease and the Amendment pursuant to its operating agreement with the Fairfield County Board of Commissioners executed on 2023. A copy of that operating agreement is attached as Exhibit 1 to this Amendment.

WHEREAS, the parties entered into the underlying Land Lease Agreement ("Lease") for a 15 year term commencing May 1, 2017 to rent hangar space to Lessee at the Fairfield County Airport ("Premises"). A copy of the current Land Lease Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 to this Amendment.

WHEREAS, while the underlying Lease does not expire until April 30, 2032, the parties desire to amend **Section XII. Option to Renew** to permit the Lessee an option to renew for 2 additional 5 year terms so long as conditions outlined below are met.

STATEMENT OF THE AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the Lessor, and Lessee agree as follows:

- 1. Section XII. "Option to Renew" is deleted and rewritten as follows:
 - a. Lessee shall have the option to renew this lease for two (2) additional five (5) year terms, provided that the Lessee has complied with the following:
 - (i) Lessee has not defaulted on any of the other terms of the Lease contained berein; and
 - (ii) Lessee is actively operating its business on the Premises during the lease and renewal term(s).
 - b. Notwithstanding the previous subsection, Lessee's option to renew must be approved by Lessor in order to be valid. Lessee shall notify Lessor of its intent to renew not less than thirty (30) days before the termination of the Lease term. If Lessee fails to notify the Lessor of its intent to renew or if the Lessor declines to accept Lessee's option to renew, the Lease shall terminate on the expiration date of the term, so long as Lessee is not otherwise in default of the Lease terms.

Except as modified herein, all terms, covenants and conditions contained in the Lease shall remain in full force and effect.
