#### Meeting to order

Glenn Burns called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance. Also present were Staci Knisley, Pat Rooney, Al Moyer, Lonnie Rush, and Lori Leach.

#### Opportunity for the Public to Address the Board

Mr. Lonnie Rush, Tenant in Q1 informed the Board that there was an excess of dog feces in grass near his hangar.

Mr. Moyer stated that there has been an aggressive dog near the hangars.

Dr. Burns asked that Mr. Moyer, Mr. Ferguson, and Mr. Rooney look into Mr. Rush's concern.

#### Approval of Minutes for the November 13, 2017

On motion of Pat Ferguson and second of Michael Kaper, the Fairfield County Airport Authority Board voted to approve the minutes from the November 13, 2017 meeting.

Voting aye thereon: McNeer, Kochis, Burns, Fagan, Ferguson, Szabrak, and Kaper Motion passed.

#### Historical Aircraft Squadron (HAS) update

Mr. Moyer informed the Board that HAS have addressed several grounds issues. They have repaired and replaced boundary lights with LED's. Howard Electric installed lights on top of the windsock. Taxi lights have been replaced and the battery in the snow plow truck has been replaced.

#### Airport Manager Update

Mr. Rooney reviewed the Airport Manager Monthly report, see attached to minutes. He reported that operations are down about 20% and fuel sales are slightly down. Hangar occupancy is about 88%. He is waiting on a call from Mary Jagiello with the FAA regarding the right-hand pattern near the proposed area of the new school.

Mr. Kochis stated that he would follow up with Ms. Jagiello.

Mr. Rooney reported that the parachute is off the chart map but still in the directory. He also reported that airport traffic is up lately.

Mr. Ferguson reported that he talked with Precision Overhead Door. They will do the yearly maintenance on the hangars in the spring.

#### **Standing Committee Updates:**

#### 1. Airport Improvement – Jon Kochis

a. Crawford Murphy Tilly (CMT) Engineer's Summary Report

Mr. Kochis reviewed the Engineer's Summary Report with the Board, see attached to the minutes.

#### i. ODOT/FAA Grants

Mr. Kochis stated that the Airport will carry over 2 years of the FAA apportionment for the design of Taxiway Delta. The bidding for the light project will be done after Christmas.

ii. Airport Capital Improvement Plan (ACIP)

Mr. Kochis reported that he had a conference call with the FAA today regarding the Board's ACIP plan. The FAA recommended that changes are made. Mr. Kochis reviewed the changes with the Board.

Dr. Burns recommended no changes be made to the ACIP.

Mr. Kochis asked the Board to approve the authorization of the final ACIP. He will work with CMT on the completion of the ACIP.

#### <u>Approval of the final ACIP and authorizing the signature of President Glenn</u> Burns

On motion of Jon Kochis and second Michael Kaper, the Fairfield County Airport Authority Board approved the final ACIP and authorizing the signature of President Glenn Burns (See ACIP attached to the minutes).

Voting aye thereon: Kochis, Kaper, Burns, Fagan, Ferguson, Szabrak, and McNeer. Motion passed.

#### b. Tax Assessments/Parcels

Mr. Kochis reported that the Board will have to pay real estate taxes on the Eversole farming area due to the \$28 annual payment. All leased hangar buildings will now have their own parcels. Mr. Kaper is going to work with the Eversole's to amend their lease with the Commissioners. This will take some time. If the lease is amended, then we can apply for a tax exemption. Part of the parcel is zoned as commercial and may have to be reassessed. All leased hangars will have their own parcel soon. That will produce separate tax bills.

#### Capital Improvement Projects

i. Storm Water System Rehabilitation/Tree Clearing

Mr. Kochis reported that Kull Excavating will start soon. There is sever drainage problems that need fixed.

Mr. Ferguson reported that there is undergrowth of trees on the old Medflight property.

ii. Roof Repair – Maintenance Hangar

Mr. Kochis reported that the work will not be done until the spring due to the weather.

#### 2. Community Relations - Michael Kaper & Rick Szabrak

There was nothing new to report.

#### 3. Facilities and Grounds - Michael Kaper & Bill Fagan

#### a. Farm Leases

Mr. Kaper reported that Doug Majors is willing to have an obnoxious weed control agreement with the Board for the additional 25 acres. He will seed it in April as well as the current acreage. Mr. Kaper reviewed the draft agreement with the Board. There will be no revenue collected but added that the Airport will pay Mr. Majors \$50 per year.

Mr. Kaper will follow up with the Prosecutor's Office for their review of the agreement.

Mr. Kaper reported that Mr. Majors also farms part of Eversole's property. He rotates crop and keeps hay production here.

#### 4. FBO Liaison – Pat Ferguson

Mr. Ferguson reported he followed up with Agroscrapes. They will still be the back-up snow removal contractor.

#### 5. Finance - Glenn Burns

#### Financial Reports

Ms. Knisley asked the Board to review the financial reports and asked if there are any questions.

Mr. McNeer reported that he visited Jon Kochis' office to view security camera monitoring.

#### 7. Tenant Relations - Glenn Burns & Bill Fagan

Ms. Knisley reported that she will follow up with Mr. Gonzales on his past due rent.

#### 8. Web – Bill McNeer & Rick Szabrak

a. Website Update

Mr. McNeer stated that Mr. Szabrak did a good job on the Airport's webpage.

Mr. Szabrak asked that the Board review policies as part of the updated webpage and he asked to get a map of the hangars.

#### **Old Business**

#### a. Columbia Pipeline

Mr. Szabrak reported that Columbia Pipeline has stated that they will work with the Airport Board. They asked that the Airport give the depth needed for the runway to go over it.

Mr. Kochis stated that it is up to Columbia Pipeline to determine the depth allowed on their pipeline according to the CMT and FAA.

Mr. Szabrak stated that Columbia Pipeline is willing to move the pipeline if the Airport purchases the property and build a runway if we can't agree on a depth.

Mr. McNeer stated that the Airport's 50-year anniversary is on June 18, 2019. He would like 2-3 Board members work on a celebration.

#### b. Airport management commencing January 1, 2019


